Contest Rules

1. Eligibility

5. How to Enter

Via Text Message: This method of entry will be available for the entire Contest Period. Send a text message with letstalktrash or freetrash from your handset to the short code 33222. In response to this text message, an auto-reply will be sent to the device. Follow the directions provided in the reply to confirm your entry. Standard text and data rates will be charged for each text message sent or received from your handset according to the terms of your carrier. Check with your wireless carrier for your handset capabilities and pricing plan details. Limit one (1) entry per person, per email address, per mobile phone number, and per household for the duration of the Contest Period, regardless of method of entry. Entries received from any person, e-mail address, mobile phone number, or household in excess of the stated limitation will be void. All entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned. If you are selected and win you are not eligible to participate again; however you may enter one time weekly if you do not win.

6. Prize Drawing
